MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

The MoU is entered into on the 19th January 2023 by and between Apollo Computer Education (here in after called Apollo Computer Education) located at RK complex, Vasavi ST, OPP, APRS, Hosur, Tamil Nadu – 635 109 and Department of Computer Science and Engineering, P.S.V College of Engineering and Technology, (here in after called PSVCET) at Krishnagiri Tamilnadu Pin - 635 108.



1. PREAMBLE

PSVCET and Apollo Computer Education have complementary interests and intend to enter into a formal MoU hereto and the development and improvement to be made under this MoU will lead to the establishment of mutual benefits of both the institutions. Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promise made herein, the parties (sometimes referred to Apollo Computer Education and PSVCET and individually as a 'party')

2. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The general purpose of this is to facilitate mutually beneficial academic and Research cooperation between the parties which may include one or more of the following:

- (1) Joint educational research activities including applications for funding to promote these activities.
- (2) Exchange of visiting Scholars for the purpose of conducting research.
- (3) Mentor for Incubation Centre.
- (4) Exchange of Undergraduate and Postgraduate students.
- (5) Exchange of Faculty members.

3. OBJECTIVES OF THE MoU

The aim of this MoU is stimulate and facilitate PSVCET to guide itself in Outcome Based Education and thereby guide for the process of Incubation Centre


Objectives are:


- A. Mentor Institute (Apollo Computer Education) will exchange their research activities with Mentee institutions.
- B. Mentor Institute (PSVCET) will conduct Faculty Development Programs concentrating on each of the parameters and process of Accreditation.
- C. Mentor Institute for (Apollo Computer Education) will conduct Workshop/ Seminars for the benefit of faculty and students of Mentee Institution (PSVCET).
- D. Mentor Institute (Apollo Computer Education) will guide and help in preparation of Incubation Centre.
- E. Mentor Institute (Apollo Computer Education) will build a strong linkage with Mentee institution (PSVCET) in relation to Incubation Centre.

4. DURATION

This MoU shall remain effective from the date of execution until the end of the term of five years.

5. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Collaborative research projects

The professors from the two institutions shall develop joint projects or research that will be used to solve the problems of the community. The parties shall engage in the cooperative joint researchers and projects, which shall include, but not limited to, technical assistance, technical consultancy and technical transfer, which shall be specified by a separate contract. With regard to joint research and development projects, joint task groups will be formed for system development and implementation.

2. Exchange information and publication

For the mutual complementary interest of both parties, Apollo Computer Education and PSVCET shall exchange information and publications in the fields of interest.

3. Student and Faculty exchange

Each party shall send its research staff and students to the other party with the objective of joining research activities. Collaborative teamwork shall be employed for participation and conducting of FDPs, conferences, workshops, seminars, preparation of expert keynotes, special lectures, paper presentations and publications in national and international journals and articles.

4. Department Coordinator

Mentee Institute (PSVCET) agrees to designate a faculty member who will be responsible to coordinate and implement activities undertaken under this MoU.
